MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT AND GENERAL MANAGER

With New Zealand at Alert Level 4, from Wednesday 19 August, the second half of the month has offered limited golf opportunities. However, we were very pleased to be able "golf in your bubble' at Alert Level 3. We wanted to reiterate the guidelines around golf at Alert Level 4 and 3. Manawatu Golf follows recommendations and guidelines set down by Sport New Zealand and Golf New Zealand. We believe that keeping our club community safe is our priority and to do this, we will follow Government guidelines and try to implement as much as possible from the advice that Golf New Zealand gives. This will give us every opportunity to be back to regular golf as soon as possible.

We are delighted to confirm that Manawatu Golf Club is one of the first partners joining the Golf New Zealand Women and Girls approach. The objective of this new programme is to ensure that our club creates a fully inclusive culture for all women and girls. There are several objectives that we are planning to work on, in partnership with Golf New Zealand, including profile, capability and leadership, creating an inclusive environment and invest in our female talent and development programmes.

The Finance Committee has been preparing the 2021/22 budget. The budget is aligned to our club strategic plan and once confirmed will enable us to achieve some our 2022 objectives. As mentioned in previous newsletter, we have conducted a review of beer and wine offerings across our bar. We have reached agreements with our main suppliers and post the return to Level 2 and Level 1, hope to be able to implement some new offerings in the bar.

We were scheduled to host the 87th Devil's Own tournament 24-26 September. Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 alert level setting throughout the country, the Devil's Own organising committee has decided to postpone this year's event. The organising committee had noted that this was the first time since World War II, that the staging of this event has been interrupted. We are currently working the organising committee to secure an alternative date, in late Summer 2022. This postponement means the course will be open for play for members and bookings will be available through regular methods.

We hope you got a chance to enjoy some golf at Level 3 and now that we are in Level 2 you are enjoying golf with other members.

A message from the Club Captain

Well, Covid-19 has hit us again and had some effect on playing golf and our competitions.

Club Champs is the pinnacle of the golfing season. For the men, qualifying still is your best round from potentially 2 opportunities to qualify, just this year there is 4 weeks between them! With the shortened period to play rounds, and the fact that by the time matches are arranged often the best tees and times are already taken by others, we will be using Club draws for round 2, semi-finals & final. As per usual Club draws, the booking sheet will be opened on the Wednesday evening prior to each Saturday, if you don't want to use the club draw process. Matches will get priority for time and tee. Enter at https://www.manawatugolfclub.com/members-area

For Club Champs, the top 16 in each grade qualify for the Main draw (matches played off the stick), and the next 16 qualify for the Handicap draw (shots given based on handicap). First round losers in the Main draws enter Flights (left hand side of draw sheets in Card room), these are played off the stick. The draws should be available online and in the Card room from Monday 20th September.

The 2 big messages that we repeat every year are (1) organise to play your matches EARLY then enter it into the Club draw if appropriate. (2) If you are away for an extended period or for the finals day then please do not enter this year.
